WKSC Social Media Policy

All Players, Spectators and Club Officials must be wary of the repercussions of the improper and inappropriate use of Social Media.

- 1. The definition of Social Media websites/ forums includes but is not limited to:
 - a) Facebook;
 - b) Instagram;
 - c) Twitter;
 - d) Snapchat;
 - e) LinkedIn;
 - f) MySpace;
 - g) YouTube;
 - h) Flickr;
 - i) Pinterest;
 - j) Tumblr;
 - k) Wikipedia;
 - I) Any other social networking sites, video and photo sharing websites, weblogs, forum and discussion boards, and online encyclopaedias; and
 - m) Any other website which allows users to use publishing instruments.
- 2. Documents, images and comments of Western Knights Soccer Club ("the Club") containing the Club logo must not be posted or published on Social Media websites/ forums without the written consent and approval of the Club's board members.
- 3. Players, Spectators and Club Officials are encouraged to use their best judgment when using Social Media, and not publish comments, material, photos or videos containing language or images that is offensive, discriminatory, provocative or hateful towards any other individual person, gender, race, nationality, ethnicity, religion, or their ability, language or physical appearance.

The Club respects each individual's right to freedom of speech. However, where the Club or the sport itself is considered to have been brought into disrepute by Players, Parents, Club Members or Spectators, the Club will take actions to discipline or penalise the relevant person/s.

Contravention of this policy may result in a reprimand, fine, ban, exclusion, suspension or expulsion of players.
